A Letter from Our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Happy New Year to one and all.

My Christmas gift to you last weekend was to share with you what St Augustine expressed after being away from the Catholic Church for years.

As my New Year's gift to you, I have more from St Augustine to share. Remember that he lived in the late 300s AD until 430 AD. The Roman Empire was collapsing and at the time of his death barbarians were at the gate of his city in North Africa. The West was about to enter the Dark Ages, and yet this bishop was in the process of helping future ages know the essence of the faith. And in a remarkably new way. He was what one might call the father of personalism, the first psychologist, the first one to write an autobiography of such profound spiritual depth. He speaks very well to the people of our own time.

Here is another snippet from his writings:

Who will grant it to me to find peace in you? Who will grant me this grace, that you should come into my heart and inebriate it, enabling me to forget the evils that beset me and embrace you, my only good? What are you to me? Have mercy on me, so that I may tell. What indeed am I to you, that you should command me to love you, and grow angry with me if I do not, and threaten me with enormous woes? Is not the failure to love you woe enough in itself?

Alas for me! Through your own merciful dealings with me, O Lord my God, tell me what you are to me. Say to my soul, I am your salvation. Say it so that I can hear it. My heart is listening, Lord; open the ears of my heart and say to my soul, I am your salvation. Let me run towards this voice and seize hold of you. Do not hide your face from me: let me die so that I may see it, for not to see it would be death to me indeed.

A good thought, don't you think, for us as we begin our new year?

Carta de Nuestro Pastor

Enero 1º 2012

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

¡Feliz Año Nuevo !

Mi regalo de Navidad el fin de semana pasado fue compartir con ustedes lo que San Agustín expresó cuando regresó a la Iglesia Católica hasta los 33 años de edad. Como mi regalo de Año Nuevo para usted, tengo más de San Agustín para compartir. Recuerda que él vivió a finales de AD 300 hasta el 430 AD. El Imperio Romano se estaba derrumbando y en el momento de su muerte, los bárbaros estaban a las puertas de su ciudad en el norte de África.

El Occidente estaba a punto de entrar a la Edad Media, y, sin embargo este obispo estaba en el proceso de ayudar a las edades futuras a conocer la esencia de la fe. Y de una manera muy renovada. Fue lo que podríamos llamar el padre del personalismo, el primer psicólogo, el primero en escribir una autobiografía de tal profundidad espiritual profunda. Habla muy bien a la gente de nuestro tiempo.

He aquí otro fragmento de sus escritos:

"¿Quién me concederá encontrar la paz en ti? ¿Quién me dará esa gracia, que entrando en mi corazón, embriagándolo y permitiéndome olvidar los males que me acosan y abrazando tú, mi único bien? ¿Qué eres para mí? Ten piedad de mí, para que yo pueda decir, verdaderamente que soy yo para ti, para que me has mandado quererte, y te enojaras conmigo, si no lo hago, y me amenazan con problemas enormes? ¿No es la falta de amor suficiente aflicción?

"¡Ay de mí! A través de tu propia misericordia te mantienes conmigo, OH Dios mío, dime lo que tú eres para mí. Di a mi alma, yo soy tu salvación. Dilo para que yo pueda oír. Mi corazón está escuchando, .. Señor, abre los oídos de mi corazón y diré a mi alma, yo soy tu salvación Quiero correr hacia esta voz y apoderarme de ti, no te escondas de mí tu rostro: déjame morir para que yo pueda ver, por para no ver que sería la muerte para mí en verdad. "

Una buena reflexión no creen? Para que iniciemos un nuevo año.
