The Best of Father Bill

Our pastor is on a well-deserved vacation this month. We'll reprint some of his columns from the past while he's away. This one's from Jan 8, 2006:

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

One of our young people who comes to the Sunday evening Mass gave me something as she and her family were coming out of Mass. It seems that the whole family read Anne Rice's book, **Christ the Lord, Out of Egypt**, after I had recommended it as good Advent reading. (The book is an historical novel about at 7 and 8 years old.) The piece of paper was her book report! The name of the 11-year-old is Michaela McKeown; and here are some snippets from her book report:

*In **Christ the Lord, Out of Egypt** Jesus is trying to find out why he can do special things and what is disparate about himself. His parents did not want him to know so he would grow up being ordinary. However, Christ was curious and wanted to know about the angel coming to his mother. How will he find out? Who should he turn to since his parents refuse to tell him?*

I enjoyed this story because I read about Jesus' life from an author rather than from the Bible. Jesus talks about how he loathed killing and sometimes he wanted to help but he did not know how.

The meaning of the story is to obey your parents because they know what's sensible for you. This is shown when Jesus finds out that, because of him, all the babies in Bethlehem under the age of two were decimated. His parents had been protecting him from this so that he would not be upset and cry and cry the way he did when he found out.

I thought you'd enjoy this; and if you haven't yet read the book, maybe Michaela's interest will attract your interest.

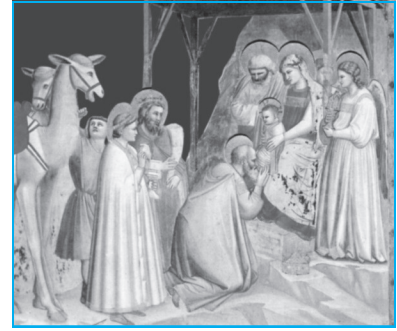
