1. Opening prayer led by Father Bill
2. Minutes were approved from May meeting
3. Parish/Church Update – Michelle Anderson

We have received a major donation from the Sullivan Foundation (located in Florida) for many school improvements that will be completed prior to the beginning of the school year. At the beginning of September, the Sunday morning Mass times will be changed from 8:30 and 10:30 to 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM.

4. Building Committee Update – Michelle Anderson

HVAC bids are coming in around \$250,000.00. Performance of this work will likely be put off until next year. The long term solution for the parking lot is very costly and our parking problem will be aggravated when the Casey School deletes the parking lot at the top of 13th St. Parking lot improvements this year will be limited to patching, sealing and striping.

5. Finance Update – Michelle Anderson

Our fiscal year budget is balanced and has been submitted to and approved by the archdiocese.

6. School Update – Pam Jackimiec

Current enrollment is at 330, not including the pre-school attendance. Currently there is an opening for a music teacher for grades K through 8. The cafeteria will continue to provide hot lunches and will be staffed with volunteers. There will likely be an increase in price for lunch.

The Mass for Jan was well attended and the 24 hour adoration conducted on her part was completely covered. Her going-away dinner was great and definitely appreciated.

7. Mayfair Update – Michelle Anderson

The Paddle Raiser netted around \$76,000.00 for gym improvements. The work is expected to be completed this summer.

8. Volunteer Ministry Oversight – Michelle Anderson

The volunteer drive undertaken to continue the parish ministries previously performed by our paid staff has been very successful. The number of volunteers who have stepped forward is overwhelming. The volunteer coordinator position (a paid position) remains open at this time.

9. Pastoral Council Re-organization – Father Bill

A group of potential new Council members will be identified and asked to be part of the new council. Volunteer leaders of each ministry will be part of the new council.

10. Closing Prayer – Father Bill
